- We want optimal conditions for the use of public transport and bicycles.
- We want poaching to be stopped, and animal habitats, our forests, not to be cleared.
- We also call for action to be taken on illegal fishing, especially on rare species of fish.
- We want to see quotes that encourage environmental protection on each abandoned building or on some billboards.
- We want the implementation of rules for companies that put out waste and fines for non-compliance.
- We request the creation of recycling stations.
- We want to ban high-emission cars, more frequent checks, the implementation of penalties for those who do not comply with the rules, a greater responsibility of the authorities.
- We want to be able to use electricity from natural sources.

WHAT COMMITMENTS WE MAKE
